The Big Idea:

What can our church do better than 10,000 others? Every church has a general calling to glorify God and make disciples. The Kingdom Concept helps to define the unique calling of Cities Church. It helps to name the unique contribution you bring to the Kingdom table in the Twin cities.

Remember: This step is a “thinking step”. We’re looking for precision language not persuasion language. This functions as a blueprint that will help inform other work we do. This is an internal document for the leadership team. It will not be used externally.


3. Share completed work with Clarity House your final Big Sentence work.

What fills our prayers? • What do we celebrate and high-five about most? • If this team stays together 10 years, what 2-3 things would we want to be our legacy? • What gets us out of bed in the morning? • What keeps you up at night? • If we asked congregants what our leadership is most passionate about, what would we hear repeated?
